Opinion on the Sustainability of Water Allocations, Prospective Acquisition of Chemical Manufacturer

A prospective purchaser wished to obtain an opinion on the sustainability of existing water allocations to a chemical manufacturer, as part of a due-dilligence process.

Existing records relating to water licinging, monitoring and water balance over the entire process at 3 manufacturing sites were examined.

Opinion was obtained from the water regulator relating to abstraction allocations within surrounding groundwater areas, including the degree of any apparent over-allocation and the possibility of resumption of licenses.

The existing and likely future proposed regulatory framework was reviewed and the attitude of the regulator to existing abstraction and future competing requirements was sought.

The view of the water undertaker was sought in regard to its ability to meet future projected demands from scheme water using existing & proposed new sources, including proposals for water recycling.
